Every month it costs the council \$135.00, give or take a few dollars, depending on how many pages need to be printed, to print and mail the KnightNews to the members of the council that request a hardcopy of the newsletter. That amounts to \$1620.00 per year. This is a significant amount. Please consider getting your copy of the KnightNews electronically. A day or so before the printed and mailed copies of the KnightNews are received by the members, an Adobe Acrobat (.pdf) file of the newsletter is uploaded to the council website at <http://www.kofc4588.org> where it may be viewed, or downloaded and printed on your own computer. This saves the council a minimum of around \$1.42 each. And the price of postage and printing keeps going up, while the cost of the electrons used to move the newsletter file from the council website and your own computer never changes, because they are constantly being reused and recycled! And a friendly email message is sent by the KnightNews Editor, yours truly, as soon as the file is available for viewing or downloading, furthering the fraternal contact between the council and the members. Thank you for taking the time to read this, and I hope you will consider doing this—think of it as a contribution to your brother Knights.

# Building Fund Committee Report

Brothers,

This information pertains to a motion that the council will be voting on at the June Business Meeting/

Attached is the recommendation from the Building Fund Committee (BFC) regarding the disposition of the BF and the creation of a new fund, called the "Legacy Fund".

Upon reviewing the results of the survey administered by Bro. Chuck Harding, the BFC came to the following conclusions:

It is appropriate and acceptable to change the usage of the Building Fund (BF) from its current restriction to a fund that has broader uses. It is prudent to create an "independent group" to review and recommend all requests for uses of money from the new fund. The new fund should not be allowed to grow indefinitely nor not be permitted to fall below a floor. The 10% tax on all events, as in the BF, should continue.

I want you to know that the members of the BFC reached a compromise through a series of discussions and alternative proposals. One overriding issue was donation of \$4,000.00 to St. Charles Church that was made at the February business meeting. The BFC unanimously agreed that topic was not in our charter to determine and any inclusion of it in our recommendation would almost certainly scuttle any chances for our proposal to be accepted by the membership.

There were major differences within the BFC regarding the how the BF money should be used in both the near and long term. The BFC had further disagreements on how large the new fund be allowed to grow and how small it be allowed diminish; how much if any money be immediately spent on important needs; should funding of new Fund be collected in some manner other than the 10% tax.

In spite of these differences the BFC was able to arrive at a solution that was satisfactory to each of the BFC members. I can assure you that not every Council member is going to agree with all parts of the recommendation. I can also assure you that some members will agree on some parts and these same members will disagree on other parts.

Finally, I urge you to carefully read and think about the recommendation in its entirety, even if you disagree with some of the provisions, and how it provides a new direction and uses of the money currently in the Building Fund, while continuing to provide a source of money for future Council charitable activities.

## Specific Recommendations

- Establish a new fund titled "Legacy Fund"

### Purpose

Enable Large Charitable Donations  
Invest in Projects or Activities for future revenue  
Donations to St. Michael's & St. Charles

### Management

GK appoints 5 man rotating Committee. (one officer, one trustee, three non-officers) Committee reviews requests.  
After review & recommendations, 2/3 vote required of meeting attendees after notifications.

- Cap of \$40,000, Floor of \$20,000
- 10% tax to continue as-is, when cap is reached, tax to go to General Fund
- Transfer all of current Building Fund into Legacy Fund
  - One time transfer of \$5,000 to General Fund
    - \$1,000 Council emergency
    - \$2,000 Knights Helping Knights
    - \$2,000 to St. Michael's School for tuition assistance

- Loans from the LF are permitted upon the recommendation of Legacy Committee.  
Loan requests shall contain a plan for repayment. Loans may be approved by a plurality of the members voting.

- Eliminate Building Fund from By-Laws after Legacy Fund is Officially Approved

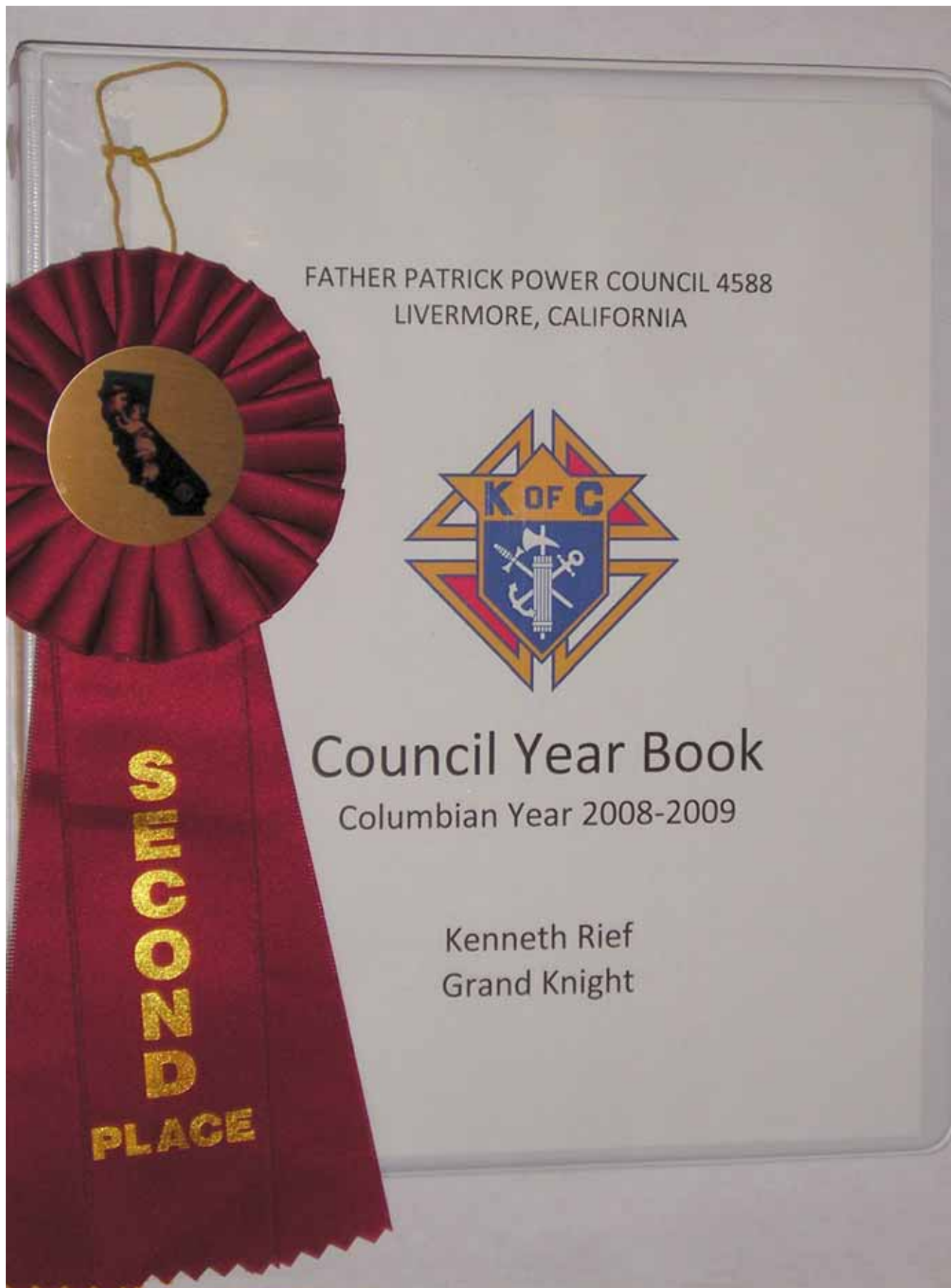

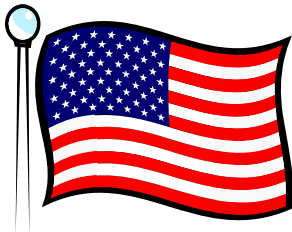
